MIDNIGHT SQUARES CLUB MEETING, 12 December 2004 Minutes

- 1. Minutes: The person our secretary Arthur Morris arranged to take his place in taking minutes for the meeting did not show up. There were no volunteers to take the minutes, so Jeff Hamilton said he would do so in addition to running the meeting.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: on file in the club locker. Presented by Don Queen. Club is doing well financially. Income from membership is continuing to come in. Class instructors have not received any payments yet.
- 3. Membership renewals/Database:
 - a. Renewals were mailed out last week (thank you Don and Woody), and are starting to come back in. It was noted that if someone did not receive a renewal notice it is because their membership was either included in their Advanced class dues, or were paid for at the same time as they paid for the C1 or C3A classes.
 - b. Mary Jane Wood (Woody) indicated that she will be meeting shortly with Judith Stevenson to turn over the database.

 - e. PACE: January and February weekend schedules are being adjusted as a trial to see if further revisions are in order. For example, C3 will be on Saturday afternoon and 2 sessions of C3A will be on Sunday.
 - f. Top Cats: Club is thinking of possibly holding a C3A class next year.

- 7. 2008 San Francisco A&C Fly-in:
 - a. No report.
- 8. Upcoming Dances:
 - a. 21 November 2004 dance with Bill Eyler: Dance had about 50 attendees, with poor turnout from the East Bay and South Bay. After the dance, Bill emailed Gary and noted how attendance fell way off towards the end of the dance. This prompted further discussion.
 - b. Discussion was held regarding how attendance at our dances always drop off, with few people sticking around until the end. It was thought that incentives

- (such as a raffle at the end of the dance) would not work to keep people in attendance. It was thought that maybe the dances were too long, went too late on Sundays, had too many levels, etc. It was noted that the club should continue working towards not having a split mentality between the levels, as has happened with other area upper level clubs. However, it was agreed that more "pizza" dances should be held (i.e., A2/C1 2-hour dance, break, C2/C3A 2-hour dance). Dances with fewer levels covered should also be offered. Based on this discussion, details of the many of the remaining 2005 dances were hammered out.
- c. 1/9/05 (changed from 1/16/04 after the meeting after consulting with Kris and several club members) Member Appreciation Dance with Kris Jensen: 2:30-5:30; A1 (Kris will be told of the several A1 calls the class will not have been taught), A2, Full C1, with one C2 star tip and one class-level C3A star tip called by Harlan; C1 class will meet before dance from 1-2:30, A and C3A classes will be dark; Friends School; Members who have renewed free and Nonmembers/nonrenewing members \$8; Coordinators Lily Hickman and Judith Stevenson.
- d. 3/6/05 Winter Dance with Saundra Bryant: 1:00-3:00 A1/A2/C1; 3:00-3:30 Pizza; 3:30-5:30 C2/C3A; all classes dark; Friends School; Members \$8 and Nonmembers \$10; Coordinator Gary Young.

- h. 9/10/05 (Saturday evening) Annual Anne Dance with Anne Uebelacker: Discussion was tabled in regards to levels, location, etc. Coordinator will be Richard Rockwell.
- i. Fall Dance: Gary and his dance committee will most likely work with FCD (11/6), ECR (11/13), or DD (12/4) to share a caller. Our experience with Sacramento for the Nov 2004 dance was not entirely smooth.
- j. Gary will continue working on getting contracts signed, with copies provided to the individual dance coordinators and club treasurer. Jeff will work with Judith and Lily on the dance checklist for the January dance.
